Call To Order

Chairman Starkey called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m.

**Invocation

Public Comment

Citizens are given an opportunity to comment on items listed on the Agenda by participating via WebEx during the meeting or attending in person. A WebEx pre-registration process can be found on the Public Comment Options page and must be completed to participate. Citizens may also comment on items listed on the Agenda in person inside the Board Room. The Board will take Public Comment on items on this agenda. It is requested that when you address the Board, that comments are not directed personally against a commissioner or team member, but rather directed at the issues. This provides mutual respect between the board members and the public.

Chairman Starkey reviewed the procedures to be followed and called for public comment.

Ms. Diane Redman, Mr. Kevin Taggerty, Ms. Barbara Barthle, Ms. Connie LaMarca, and Ms. Karen Menard, member of the Dade City Garden Club, spoke regarding personal histories; wanting preservation of the oak tree at the Historic Courthouse; a large tree that had been removed decades ago; damage that had been caused by roots; concerns with structure damage to the memorial; pictures displayed by Mr. Taggerty and those he was speaking for; wanting the tree to be registered as a historic tree; how old it was and historical events it had lived through; proper care; arborist reports; that there was no visible failing of the tree; sabal palms; money to fix and protect memorials; oxygen and shade that was provided by the tree; forms that would be filled out; speaking with the City; work that was needed on the memorial; the beauty of the City and the County; unity in the community; State protections for trees; responsibilities of the County and the City; Dade City's Tree City USA designation; and upholding goals.

Ms. Paula Baracaldo, Director of Support Services, spoke regarding that through the funds received from the Opioid Settlement fund, Pasco County had been recognized at the State and National level for its efforts to address behavioral health needs for the community.

Ms. Tracey Kaly, Director of Ambulatory Clinical Services for BayCare Behavioral Health, spoke during the discussion.

Discussion was held regarding Pasco County opening the first Behavioral Health Urgent Care Center in the State of Florida; their forward thinking; the community; an invitation to visit the center; the number of people that had been served since it had opened; services provided; whether there were transportation barriers; moving forward to the next phase; the location that had been picked; the phenomenal accomplishment; the unhoused population; keeping people out of jail and the hospitals; when the idea was

generated; that it was a great use of the Opioid Settlement money; and a proposal to have another one on the other side of the County that would be coming before the Board at a later date.

Updates from Chairman-Appointed Boards and Committees

- The updates were provided under Miscellaneous Business.

Miscellaneous Business - District One - Commissioner Oakley

- Commissioner Oakley spoke regarding not being ready to discuss the tree item, emails he had received, new information that had come up today, and wanting to get more information.

Discussion was held regarding that an arborist would be coming to look at the tree; that Facilities would be bringing more information back; the tree canopy; wanting to see oak trees; shade; valuing grand trees better; land clearing; working to protect the trees; trees that had been damaged during a storm and have not been replanted; what other counties did; and tree surveys.

- Later in the meeting, he spoke regarding the lobbyist changes.

Mr. Ralph Lair, Intergovernmental Affairs Officer, spoke during the discussion.

Discussion was held regarding the federal lobbyist contract with Ballard Partners and how they had been doing; meetings in Washington; initial contact and comments; following the terms of the agreement; the purchasing process; that it took time; meeting with Ballard; the Army Corps of Engineers; specific projects; whether they could send them a notice; the Housing Authority Voucher discussion; permitting; Ridge Road; providing feedback to the lobbyists; defining expectations; the local lobbyist contracts; whether they wanted to go from three to two; what had gotten through; a request for a recap; that Pinellas County had gotten zero; needing to look into it on their own; that the cities had their own lobbyists; what the Governor had signed; whether the Board wanted them to bring an item back to a future meeting; what they could do the next year; working with DOT; specific Bills; funding requests; recommendation letters; and delegation meetings.

Discussion was held regarding a parcel that used to be an auto repair shop; and what they had done in Bentonville, Arkansas.

- Later in the meeting, she spoke regarding an article in the paper pertaining to Tampa Bay Water and the PFAS Lawsuit.

Mr. Adolfo Gonzalez, Director of Utilities Engineering and Contract Management, spoke during the discussion.

Discussion was held regarding the PFAS Lawsuit Settlement Funds; Temple Terrace; PFAS numbers; the two claims that were filed; Tampa Bay Water; projects; remediation efforts; that bulk water would be treated before it came to them; bad wells; a neighborhood in Holiday; and private utilities.

- She spoke regarding a request to send a letter to Chancellor Kevin O'Farrell, Florida Department of Education, pertaining to AmSkills and apprenticeship programs.
