Updates from Chairman - Appointed Boards and Committees

The updates were given under Miscellaneous Business.

Miscellaneous Business - District One - Commissioner Oakley

- Commissioner Oakley displayed pictures and spoke regarding the graduation of students coming into the new fire department, how many graduated, hiring students, the brother and sisterhood, appreciation for those in the fire department, an emergency call story, the increase in numbers, and reopened stations.
- He displayed pictures and spoke regarding the Topping Off of the AdventHealth new office building, signing a beam, and the event attendance.
- He spoke regarding the new antique mall in Dade City, that there was a lot of vendors, the antique warehouses in other places, the days they were open, and the encouragement to spend time there.

Miscellaneous Business - District Two - Commissioner Weightman

- Commissioner Weightman spoke regarding the request to waive temporary permit fees for Operation StandDown, when it would take place, that it was the largest event of the year, where it was located, and the services provided at the event.

Approved to waive the four-hundred-dollar fee.

- He spoke regarding the Red Sand Event, appreciation for everyone who helped and came out, event attendance, the positive tone, and the hope that it would be a regular event.
- He spoke regarding whether there would be a Legislative conversation.

Later in the meeting, the Board returned to this item.

- Mr. Ralph Lair, Intergovernmental Affairs Officer, spoke regarding the final week of Session, the amount of Bills passed, the budget plan, the Conference, the House and Senate budgets and projects, the Governor's ability to act on a passed budget, legislation that could impact local government, what was discussed at the meeting with HUD, the upcoming meeting with the Army Corps of Engineers, issues to be discussed, projects submitted for consideration, the completion of the 26' budget, and the notification to submit the request back.

Mr. David Goldstein, Chief Assistant County Attorney, and Mr. David Engel, Director of Planning, Development and Economic Growth, spoke during the discussion.

Discussion was held regarding the awareness of the Section 8 vouchers; Local Preference; prioritization before voucher distribution; Davis-Bacon for everyone applicable; the request to add the boat ramps at Anclote River Park to the Army Corps meeting; the sign up with Dawson & Associates; Ridge Road; Sunwest; the joint work for a channel permit; Congressional asks; allocations to non-profits; Parkway Boulevard location and issues; the work with schools; sidewalks; Safe Streets to Schools projects; the great work of the team; the Department of Transportation's presentation; the topic of safety; the BUILD Grants; the CSX Bridge application; the County Line Road project submission; the conversation with the Department of Labor; the lobbyist's good job; the pamphlet distributed by Commissioner Starkey; appreciation for Mr. Lair; the potential changes to Live Local; the different versions; an evolving legislation concern; affordable housing; what Hillsborough County was doing; challenging the Bill; the issues with the Bill; appreciation for Commissioner Weightman and Mr. Goldstein's efforts; what happened in Seminole County; potential hope for next year; the Senate Bill 180 lawsuits; suing Live Local Developers as opposed to the State; the opt-out; housing shortage and affordability information in Tallahassee; sharing Pasco County's numbers compared to other Counties; green field removal; whether the Comp Plan could be adopted; The City of Ocoee's lawsuit; the Planning Commission's hearings on the Comp Plan; the Comp Plan schedule; Pasco 2025; Bill 927 issues; preemptive Land Use Bills; the monitoring and status of Bills; Blue Ribbon Bill concerns; a public meeting in Vero Beach; an Epic City; the Sadowski funds; rollback rate impacts; and the HOA Bill.

Miscellaneous Business - District Three - Commissioner Starkey

- Commissioner Starkey spoke regarding the passing of Mr. Matt Call, developers for Starkey Ranch, the P-4, the agreement to maintain the park, the request to dedicate the park to Mr. Call, to add signage, and a future ceremony.

Mr. David Goldstein, Chief Assistant County Attorney, spoke during the discussion.

Discussion was held regarding being the first P-4 in the state.

Approved to add a sign called the Matt Call Memorial Park to be placed at the park.

- She spoke regarding the meeting on the DeCubellis Widening, a light controversy, the road's need for high-level functionality, supporting Staff's plan, a potential sound wall concern, a landscaping request, and the wall placement.

Discussion was held regarding concerns on who would get the wall; the HOA; a maintenance issue; to potentially extend the existing wall; room for the trail; the

Tree Mitigation Fund for landscaping; the benefits of the light; why they might have removed the light; trail access; the maps displayed; and the light speed.

- She spoke regarding a bike ride with Staff and engineers in Starkey Ranch, neighborhood connectivity, how the neighborhood was designed and planned, and educating people.
- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding an award from the Ambassador of Germany to the U.S., the amount of awards given out, why she received the award, the pin and challenge coin received, to keep the relationships up, and to get the young co-workers to switch again.
- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding going to NACo, who attended, visiting the delegation, the lobbyist's better job, traction on key issues, a pamphlet she distributed, and the encouragement for the other Commissioners to go to Washington D.C.
- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding the Trinity Odessa Leadership Council meeting, that it was well received, the motorized bike issues, ATV's driven into retention ponds, who spoke, and her appreciation for the Staff who attended.
- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding her son-in-law's pinning ceremony, who attended, and the story of pinning the bird.

Discussion was held regarding the celebration and what a great young man he was.

- She spoke regarding the tour of the Pentagon.
- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding the Harbor South Leadership Council meeting, her appreciation for Staff, folks on the coastal side, and Ms. Kelly Sinn's presentation and organization.

Later in the meeting, the Board returned to this item.

- Commissioner Starkey spoke regarding research on Epic City and a correction regarding Vero Beach.

Miscellaneous Business - District Four - Commissioner Yeager

- Commissioner Yeager displayed pictures and spoke regarding the Pop-Up Pantry at Moon Lake, the weather, the support from the Pasco County Sheriff's Office, healing for an officer, the amount of people served, and story time.

- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding appreciation for the help received, supplies needed for the senior store, and that donations were always welcome.

Discussion was held regarding the location; the storage unit; and the types of donations.

- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding appreciation for Fire Station 15 and a successful child visit.
- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding Sprouts Horizon Sports Park, the amenities the park had, and taking County Staff there.

Discussion was held regarding the appropriation; who put money towards the park; and how much the facility cost.

Miscellaneous Business - District Five - Commissioner Mariano

- Chairman Mariano displayed pictures and spoke regarding Florida Sports Coast winning the bronze medal for the Adrian Award, the celebration for it, and appreciation for the team.
- He displayed pictures and spoke regarding going to D.C., who was in the pictures displayed, the meetings attended, the Jefferson Library, Senator Moody's weekly morning meetings, and the Department of Labor.
- He displayed pictures and spoke regarding the Hudson Clean-Up and a homeless camp concern.
