Miscellaneous Business - District One - Commissioner Oakley

- Chairman Oakley spoke regarding a tour in New Port Richey with the City of New Port Richey City Manager Ms. Debbie Mann, City of New Port Richey Rob Marlowe, and Mr. Pete Altman and displayed pictures for the Board. He noted the La Hacienda building was built in 1922 and was being renovated to be a hotel in the future.
- He spoke regarding the boundaries for the Moratorium and explained he did not want his District to be included.

Discussion was held regarding the boundaries; the past action of the Board; moving forward; which areas were included; and projects with previously approved entitlements.

Approved to provide more direction to Staff about what would be brought forward to less out the area of District One which was included in the current map that had been generated prior to advertising the Moratorium by a roll call vote.

Miscellaneous Business - District Two - Commissioner Moore

- Commissioner Moore explained there were parcels of land on the list of lands available for taxes that were currently needed by the County. He noted one would be needed for a future project and would be needed to maintain existing right-of-way.

- He spoke regarding the recent Central Permitting audit and expressed his appreciation to Ms. Alvarez-Sowles and her team for their efforts.
- He spoke regarding that the United States Premier Hockey League season had come to an end, a recent event that had been held at AdventHealth Center Ice, that it brought approximately 4,500 room nights in Pasco County, and conversations held with the League Commissioner.
- He spoke regarding a meeting that Mr. Biles would be attending later in the evening concerning a CRA, an incorrect statement made at a previous meeting regarding the authority to change boundaries, and a specific street in Port Richey which had a high taxable value.
- He expressed his appreciation to Fire Chief Andy Fossa, Emergency Management Director, Mr. Mike Napier, Florida Department of Health, their teams, and all nurses, paramedics, and EMTs for their efforts regarding the vaccine distribution. He noted his wife had recently volunteered to administer vaccines.

Miscellaneous Business - District Three - Commissioner Starkey

- Commissioner Starkey spoke regarding the HRE (High Return Enforcement) Team, statistics she had recently received, issues that were encountered regarding a property on U.S. 19 which turned into a homeless camp, and the condemnation process.
- She led discussion regarding that she had been approached by the Civic Association of Gulf Harbors regarding signage on the back of canals, especially for emergencies or addresses, health and safety concerns, and the need for Manatee signs and No Wake Signs.

- She explained that at the Suncoast and 54 Trailhead there was only one Port-a-Potty and requested to use the reserves for another Port-a-Potty until they figured out something else.

Discussion followed regarding the cleaning; the number of people who used it; that the Parks department was working on it; and that many complaints had been received.

Approved for another Port-a-Potty to be placed at the Suncoast and 54 Trailhead by a roll call vote.

- She expressed her concerns with the lack of landscaping and how bad it looked. She encouraged the Board to drive down State Road 54 or State Road 52 and spoke regarding the Orders that had been sent out with no response.
- She noted she would be going to Tallahassee the following week to meet with the DOE and the Governor Office's regarding appropriations for AmSkills and for some County items.
- She spoke regarding an article from Tampa Bay Business Journal that was written about AmSkills.
- She led discussion regarding a TV Article on Channel 8 pertaining to a road in Commissioner Fitzpatrick's District; that the road was temporarily repaired after hurricane damage with the intention to come forward with a PVAS at a later time; that the road had not failed yet; an upcoming Agenda item; a recent Agenda item; comments from residents; a potential conflict of interest; and damage to the road after the hurricane.

Miscellaneous Business - District Four - Commissioner Fitzpatrick

- Commissioner Fitzpatrick expressed her appreciation to Staff regarding a Ridge Road Extension Tour.
- She also expressed appreciation for Ms. Gina in her office for going above and beyond for a citizen.
- She explained that for the vaccines as of March 15th the Executive Order would be shifting the age requirement downward and the Floridian's eligible for the Coronavirus Vaccine under State Policy would be Long Term Care Facility people and Staff, people aged 60 and older, Front Line Health Care Workers and sworn Law Enforcement, Employees for Kindergarten through 12th grade, and Fire Fighters aged 50 or older. She noted the locations were also expanding.

- She spoke on Commissioner Starkey's comments regarding the High Return Enforcement and noted that on Graffiti Beach on Ridge Road the owners would be tearing down their building which would be completed by May 1st.
- She expressed her appreciation to Staff for their efforts regarding cleaning up specific areas.
- She led discussion regarding the Commercial Redevelopment Landscape Grant Program; the areas for which the grant was available; options for the other areas; potentially expanding Beautification Day's to just the entrances to other communities; and that municipalities could use their CRA funds however the use of the funds could not be stipulated.
- She expressed her appreciation to Staff for working diligently towards getting the Armed Force's Flags on the dais.

Chairman Oakley noted the Coast Guard Flag was missing however it would be coming in.

Miscellaneous Business - District Five - Commissioner Mariano

- Commissioner Mariano spoke on Commissioner Starkey's comments regarding landscaping. He requested for Mr. Biles to look at the landscaping for a library on Little Road.

Mr. Biles noted it would be completed as part of the remodel.

- He spoke regarding a property on Green Key Boulevard that was abutting a development that was coming in and requested for something to be brought back to the Board regarding a potential trail.
- He expressed his appreciation to the Parks Department for the Agenda item for a small boat ramp at SunWest that was approved earlier in the meeting. He felt it was going to be a big help.
- He spoke regarding the Shrimp and Crab Fest that was a great success and noted another event that would be coming up on March 20th.
- He spoke regarding another boat ramp and noted two areas that were highly scored on a report that Staff had completed and grants they were working on for the ramp.

- He spoke regarding comments made earlier in the meeting pertaining to the Mask Ordinance and explained he had information coming in about it. He asked the Board if there was anyone else who felt that the mandate should be changed.

There was no discussion.

Miscellaneous Business - County Administrator

- Mr. Biles spoke regarding pamphlets that Ms. Cathy Pearson, Assistant County Administrator for Public Services, her team, and Mr. Mike Napier, Florida Department of Health, had worked on to be distributed to people waiting in lines for vaccines and testing.
- He explained that March 10th would be one year since the first positive COVID case in Pasco County and that March 12th would be one year since the Board declared a local state of emergency. He spoke regarding data he had received regarding the vaccine.

Discussion was held regarding whether the numbers included people who came in from other counties; numbers of Pasco residents who were vaccinated in other counties; that numbers from the VA had not been received; clarifying language on who was eligible for the vaccine; a packet of information that would be sent out to the Board; buildings that were closed; coming process changes; a Remote Work Policy that had been put in place the previous year; whether Staff would be reporting back to the office; areas that used a hybrid model; whether the process for hard copies of plans submitted to sit on different tables for days was being continued; past communication issues and improvements to the process; a Vaccine Passport that was potentially coming; the Quarantine Leave Policy change that would be coming later; safety in the workplace; appreciation for the County Policy to not waste vaccines; that other counties were throwing away vaccines; vaccine scheduling; whether other entities had standardized waitlists; herd immunity; the Mask Mandate; and the hope for positive numbers in the coming weeks.

- He noted that Mr. Sam Beneck, Project Management, had received the 2020 Professional of the Year Award by the Florida Bicycle Association for his work on trails.
- He spoke regarding an increase in IT Security Training and that they went from a twenty percent click rate on phishing emails to below two percent from a County Employee perspective.

Miscellaneous Business - County Attorney

- No items.

Miscellaneous Business - Clerk and Comptroller

- Ms. Alvarez-Sowles spoke regarding the two audits that had been performed and noted it was a request from the Code Compliance Division for a review of the determination process of their use of the DAVID System. She commended the Team for an amazing job and that they were wonderful to work with the Inspector General Division.
- She spoke regarding the recent Valentine's Day Wedding Ceremony and explained there were twenty-one couples, that it was moved inside to the Jury Assembly room due to the rainy day, and that they had great help from law enforcement to gain access to the building. She noted that Ms. Cherry from downstairs was married at the ceremony.
- She explained that Jury Trials would be back on March 15th, that they were ready to keep the jurors socially distant, and would be disinfecting areas in the courthouse.
