- Chairman Oakley spoke regarding attending the 2021 Water Awareness event, displayed a picture, and noted Mr. Michael Carballa, Assistant County Administrator, attended the event as well.
- He spoke regarding the groundbreaking for Fire Station 9 in District 4, with the Fire Station being voted on by the citizens.
- He showed a video for the new Moffitt Cancer Center.

Miscellaneous Business - District Two - Commissioner Moore

- Commissioner Moore thanked Mr. Brian Ford for coming to Pasco County and bringing the Vince Lombardi Trophy.

- He spoke regarding the National Travel and Tourism Week Resolution that was approved in the Agenda. He noted that the Team Up! Event was on Thursday, May 6 with a joint partnership of the Pasco EDC.
- He spoke regarding the New River Library in Wesley Chapel reopening soon after the renovations were completed.
- He requested Staff bring back and update on the Harbor Plan for the BCC June meeting.

Miscellaneous Business - District Three - Commissioner Starkey

- Commissioner Starkey spoke regarding joint meetings with the City of Port Richey and the City New Port Richey on numerous projects such as dredging and trails.

Mr. Biles noted Staff would find a facility to be able to socially distance to meet.

- She spoke about receiving a letter from Mr. Jordan Nelson, P.E., Project Engineer, in regards to possibly adding 7 hot spot towers near the wood trails for citizens to be able to use in case of emergencies.

Mr. Biles noted that there would be an operations cost to the request and would look into the item further and would bring back the information for review.

- She thanked Senator Simpson, Speaker Sprowls, Senator Cooper, Representative Mariano, Senator Ben Albritton, Mr. Shawn Foster, and Mr. Ralph Lair for their help with the Lindrick Project and AmSkills funding.

Discussion was held on inviting the Governor to Pasco County with a guided tour of Metropolitan Ministries, Lindrick, and AmSkills.

Miscellaneous Business - District Four - Commissioner Fitzpatrick

- Commissioner Fitzpatrick spoke regarding attending the SmileFaith Dental Foundation Women's Summit, which would be offering free dental care for human trafficking, domestic violence, and addiction recovery survivors, as well as children who had aged out of foster care and for Veterans.
- She spoke regarding attending the 2nd annual Marjorie's Hope Celebrity Luncheon, with \$20,000.00 raised, and thanked Ms. Debi Shackowsky for the event that helped give children backpacks and clothing.

- She was honored to present the Water Wise Award at the Heartwood Preserve Cemetery to Ms. Laura Starkey, Executive Director.
- She encouraged everyone to pick up garbage to help keep Pasco clean.
- She spoke regarding saving the date for October 16, 2021 for the Pasco Back the Blue Event at Gill Dawg in Port Richey.
- She spoke briefly regarding Lakeside Woodlands and displayed photos of the area with barricades around the sinkholes.

Miscellaneous Business - District Five - Commissioner Mariano

- Commissioner Mariano spoke regarding Lakeside Woodlands and residents living in fear, a County road being completely unusable, 5 homes being directly affected, and the County stepping in to help the residents.

Discussion was held regarding Staff pursuing 5 different opportunities to seek outside funding and assist the residents; with most of them being denied due to a 2015 FEMA policy; and Staff bringing an item back to the Board for presentation in June.

- He spoke regarding the boat covers and asked the County Attorney about differentiating boat covers from canals and lakes.

Brief discussion was held regarding the question being brought up during the time the Ordinance was adopted distinguishing the 2.

- He spoke regarding the panhandling and the Panhandling Ordinance, and panhandlers being removed from rights-of-way due to safety, trespassing, and keeping them off the median.

Discussion was held regarding removing panhandlers, panhandling being a First Amendment Right, panhandling being only enforced if it's done in right-of-way areas, medians, or trespassing, and the Ordinance being enforced mostly for trespassing.

- He requested Staff bring back information regarding the Tree Mitigation Fund.
- He spoke regarding the Public Comment procedures that will take effect at the May 18, 2021 BCC meeting.

Miscellaneous Business - County Administrator

BCC AA 05/04/2021

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- Mr. Biles congratulated the Animal Services department on winning a couple of State awards in the last few weeks.
- He spoke regarding FAM tours being back in business, the DMO having their first tour last month, and things slowly going back to normal.
- He spoke regarding permits for single-family homes being double from last year and being up 30% in commercial. He noted that within a couple of weeks the numbers would be similar to 2019 and doubling in 2021.

Discussion was held regarding the permitting process and labor issues across the industry.

- Mr. Steinsnyder spoke regarding the Opioid litigation and litigation assessment, and informed the Board of a possible meeting in June to discuss how to move forward.

She thanked Mr. Manny Long, Director of Financial Services, and Mr. Matthew Lazar, Finance Assistant Director, and their leadership, as well as County Staff for their help with the report, and noted that the report was available for viewing on the Clerk's website.
