Ms. Wanda Stevens and Mr. Wayne Davidson spoke regarding health issues caused by lime rock dust from Bohannon Road, a request from the County for donated property, and neighborhood petitions. She requested that the road be paved. Discussion was held between the Board, Staff, and Ms. Stevens regarding paving assessments; the history of road work done on Bohannon Road; and alternative paving options.

Ms. Megan Sorbo and Ms. Alexis Foxx spoke regarding the fate of the Florida black bears, authorized bear hunts in Florida, the bears were on the threatened species list at one time, the FWC called a black bear hunt their trophy, the number of permits sold which did not have a cap, and the bears current estimated population. They requested an Ordinance banning bear hunts in Pasco County.

Ms. Judy Geiger spoke regarding the emergency signal being place at a fire station in Lacoochee, her appreciation to the Board for working on the item, Agenda Item R1 which was clothing bins that were in rights-of-way, illegal dumping, existing rules and code enforcement, and creating a premier County.
