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Call to Order

Chairman Oakley called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

**Invocation
Pledge of Allegiance**

Ms. Alvarez-Sowles gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Roll Call

Ms. Alvarez-Sowles called the roll. All Commissioners were present.

Public Comment

Citizens are given an opportunity to comment on items listed on the Agenda by participating via WebEx during the meeting or attending in person. A WebEx pre-registration process can be found on the Public Comment Options page and must be completed to participate.

Citizens may also comment on items listed on the Agenda in person inside the Board Room. The Board will take Public Comment on items on this agenda. It is requested that when you address the Board, that comments are not directed personally against a commissioner or team member, but rather directed at the issues. This provides mutual respect between the board members and the public.

Chairman Oakley reviewed the procedures to be followed.

Mr. Jon Russell, Ms. Jean Cifelli, Ms. Cindy Fargo, Ms. Madeline Capodanno, Ms. Concetta Sanfilippo, Ms. Diane Kobernick, Mr. Bill Gillies, Mr. Robert Mitchell, and Ms. Marlieta Lassiter spoke regarding The Oaks Park and Riverside Village Estates MSBU not being implemented and how it would be implemented; e-mails being sent to the Board members with no response; citizens not properly notified of the meeting regarding the MSBU and affected by COVID-19; urged the Board to reconsider the MSBU until properly notified; the County purchasing property in "as is" conditions affecting the citizens; traffic issues if an Amazon warehouse was opened there; citizens worried about high taxes in upcoming years; and mosquito control concerns.

Pastor Troy Peterson thanked Commissioner Fitzpatrick for helping with the CareFest and spoke regarding the Invocation and Prayer being recited by someone from the Somebody Cares Pastors Association.

Mr. Ron Orchard, Ms. Cheryl Orchard, and Ms. Gayle Swedberg spoke regarding flooding issues; blocked drainage pipes; safety issues; and adding Green Key to the Cities meeting on the west side on November 2, 2021.

Commissioner Mariano spoke regarding a possible Legislative ask for Green Key to help relieve the flooding issues.

Ms. Tanya Salyer spoke regarding flooding issues on Meridian Boulevard in Hudson specifically on Filly Lane.

Mr. Kurtis Marsh, Ms. Renee Rivard, and Ms. Nina Perino spoke regarding adding rabbits to the "No Sale" Ordinance along with dogs and cats; that the majority of animal rescues across the Tampa Bay area do not accept rabbits; rabbits being bought impulsively during Easter; and causing a huge rabbit population being released into neighborhoods.

Mr. Drew Bocchetti spoke regarding having septic issues, reaching out to the County Staff, the Pasco County Health Department, and Commissioner Fitzpatrick for some relief to help him out with no success.

Commissioner Fitzpatrick mentioned that he would need to reach out to Mr. Mike Napier, Director of the Pasco County Health Department, for assistance.

Ms. Miriam Butler and Mr. Charles Eldred spoke in support of the Riverside Village Estates, the Oaks MSBU, and would like that the Board enact their agreement from 2014.

Ms. Janine Dombrowski spoke regarding flooding problems on Grand Boulevard in Holiday, people swerving on the roads to avoid puddles, and an increase of traffic. She also spoke regarding the increase of panhandling and homelessness on the County Road 52 and U.S. Highway 19 corridor. She expressed her interest in programs to help with human trafficking and builders to help for affordable housing.

Commissioner Starkey asked Ms. Dombrowski to e-mail her to discuss these issues with her.

Ms. Nancy Gray and Ms. Michelle Jimenez spoke via WebEx regarding Deer Lake and flooding issues the neighborhood was facing; drainage into the lake causing properties to overflow; having private meetings with Commissioner Fitzpatrick; that the County had not looked into these issues; the lake taking approximately 9 to 12 months to drain; septic tanks being submerged due to flooding; and having no response from the County.
