Call to Order

Chairman Starkey called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

**Invocation
Pledge of Allegiance**

Ms. Alvarez-Sowles gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Ms. Alvarez-Sowles called the roll. All Commissioners were present.

Public Comment

Citizens are given an opportunity to comment on items listed on the Agenda by participating via WebEx during the meeting or attending in person. It is requested that when you address the Board, that comments are not directed personally against a commissioner or team member, but rather directed at the issues. This provides mutual respect between the board members and the public.

Mr. Doug Sanders, President of the Pasco County Historical Society, thanked Commissioner Oakley and others for replacing the sign outside of the Historic Courthouse that had the wrong date for 61 years for when Pasco County was founded.

Mr. David Terino and Mr. Chris Terino spoke on the flooding issues from the Epperson Ranch project; being told they would not experience the flooding issues; reaching out to Mr. Pat Gasaway with no response; that Tindale Road outlet had been completely closed off; being above the seasonal high; how they were not getting answers from anyone in the County; the damage the water had done to the property; there were no uplands anymore due to the water; and that the commercial property did not belong in the neighborhood.

The Honorable Mike Fasano, Tax Collector, spoke regarding the history of Pasco County, that Pasco County was considered the “stepchild” of Pinellas and Hillsborough County, that within the past five years there was a dramatic change to the County with the leadership of Mr. Dan Biles as the County Administrator, he changed Pasco County from a “bedroom community” to a leading County, and he thanked Mr. Biles for all he had done for the County.

Ms. Melissa Horn spoke regarding her support for the golf cart phase II project within her community in Hudson and where the County was regarding the maintenance of the canals.

Mr. Arnold Becken spoke regarding the dense traffic near their old home, flooding, lack of drainage on the property, that the flood waters had ruined the wells on the property, and the damage done to neighboring properties.
