This provides mutual respect between the board members and the public.

Mr. Dixon Phillips welcomed the new Commissioners and County Staff. He thanked those who helped with Hurricane Ian, spoke regarding increased emergency services call volumes, a new station that was to be built, the need to complete Fire Stations faster, resignations of firefighters, reasons why they were leaving, quality of life, comparisons to Hillsborough County, health screening and physicals needed for firefighters, agility tests, denied cancer claims, retain and recruit, fighting a claim, and the need to keep citizens safe and make Pasco County premier.

Mr. Walter McBride spoke regarding what could be done to bring in higher quality businesses into Pasco, that there were large amounts of people moving to the area, lack of amenities and quality, why are we approving certain things, that people were becoming discouraged by the lack of business qualities, and the need to upgrade the community.

Discussion was held regarding better businesses to bring into the County and ways to get them here.

Mr. Glenn Stambough spoke regarding a complaint with flooding in his driveway each rainfall, that old drainage pipes were found in a neighboring field from a project that the County did not follow through on, lack of help, and the need to get the streets and drainage fixed.

Mr. Jerry Smithson spoke regarding the growth of the Central Pasco Gulf Railroad and Crews Lake Park and the request to speak with Parks, Recreation, and Natural Resources Department to get items straightened out.

Mr. Ken Muckenfuss spoke regarding the Deer Springs zoning amendment (P109) and noted that State Road 56 was left out of the proposal.

Mr. Steinsnyder stated that Deer Springs was a Public Hearing item and that he should make his comments in the afternoon.

Ms. Ashley Adamiak spoke regarding the New Port Richey City Hall meetings, the lack of representation, police corruption, crime rates, other review boards, the need for public records to be easily obtainable, and that addresses and names should not be deemed necessary for public comment speakers and should be kept private.

Ms. Deborah Newman spoke regarding issues with a recent property purchased. She noted that she hoped to live on the property in her RV while building her house but was later told she could not. She asked for a temporary permit to live on the property instead of having to live and pay an RV Park.
