- She spoke regarding a recent meeting regarding the Orange Belt Trail. She noted that Mr. Ray Gadd, Deputy Superintendent of Schools, was unable to be in attendance at the meeting.
- She spoke regarding an upcoming study for Anclote River Park, implications for the redesign, and the need to be mindful of archeological sites.

Discussion followed regarding gold hunters at another park and cultural and historical artifacts discovered at Anclote River Park.

Commissioner Starkey spoke regarding sampling done by an archeological team, the potential gold, and a segment on the History Channel.

- She spoke regarding the recent Global Tampa Bay Mission to London, the flights there and back, other passengers on the flight, and the meeting with Moffitt.
- She spoke regarding the Anclote River bridge that was removed, options for the replacement, an easement, and funding options.

Chairman Mariano noted it was a phenomenal trip.

- He spoke regarding the offer by Somebody Cares to assist with homeless camps and the desire to work on an arrangement.

Discussion was held regarding the need for trash clean up on several County properties.

- He spoke regarding a discussion that had come up at the Citizen's Academy meeting regarding the money being spent on the lawsuit between the County and the Clerk's Office.

### **Miscellaneous Business - County Administrator**

- Mr. Carballa thanked Commissioner Weightman for his discussion on the District 7 Traffic Operations Center, and invited the Commissioners to tour Pasco County's center.
- He spoke regarding the Public Infrastructure Safety Team and their recent gold and honorable mention recognition by the Florida Safety Council for Outstanding Safety Performance and Safety Leadership.
- He spoke regarding Code Compliance Animal Services' joint efforts with the Pasco County Sheriff's Office and the Dade City Police Department to find Code violations and stolen vehicles.

- He noted Ms. Desirae Wagner had taken a position within the IT Department and Ms. Gina Jeffers would become the Agenda Coordinator. He thanked Ms. Wagner for all she had done.
- He spoke regarding the Joint Workshop that would be conducted with the Commissioners from both Pinellas County and Hillsborough County on May 12, 2023.

Commissioner Starkey spoke regarding the potential for invitations to be sent to Mayor's for future meetings.

Chairman Mariano spoke regarding the addition of a transportation discussion to the Agenda.

### **Miscellaneous Business - County Attorney**

- Mr. Goldstein thanked Mr. Andy Taylor, Legislative Aide for Commissioner Weightman, for bringing Senate Bill 1604 to his attention.

Mr. Taylor explained the recent amendment to Senate Bill 1604 that had come out.

Mr. Goldstein spoke regarding the letter approved earlier in the meeting and the need to contact lobbyists.

Ms. Joanna Cheshire, Chief of Staff, spoke during the discussion.

Discussion was held regarding language included in the Bill that may be harmful; the sponsors of the Bill; the inability to regulate any building design elements; current MPUD architectural and monotony controls; potential for voluntarily agreement by developers; the reason for the amendment; conversations with the County Administrators of other Counties; the need for continued discussions with lobbyists; the acceleration of the Bill towards passage; another Bill regarding Commissioner term limits; and scheduled Bills.
