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Call To Order

Chairman Mariano called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m.

**Invocation
Pledge of Allegiance**

Ms. Grimes gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Roll Call

Ms. Grimes called the roll. All Commissioners were present with Commissioner Bradford attending the meeting virtually.

Public Comment

Citizens are given an opportunity to comment on items listed on the Agenda by participating via WebEx during the meeting or attending in person. A WebEx pre-registration process can be found on the Public Comment Options page and must be completed to participate. Citizens may also comment on items listed on the Agenda in person inside the Board Room. The Board will take Public Comment on items on this agenda. It is requested that when you address the Board, that comments are not directed personally against a commissioner or team member, but rather directed at the issues. This provides mutual respect between the board members and the public.

Chairman Mariano reviewed Public Comment procedures to be followed.

Mr. Guy Aboussleman spoke regarding Code Violations on his property, that there were fines from the County, listed the violations, that there was a lien on his property, his proof, and asked for a reduction or for the fines to be released.

Chairman Mariano directed Mr. Robert Marin, Interim Assistant County Administrator, Development Services, to speak with Mr. Aboussleman.

Mr. John-Michael Morin, Pasco Professional Fire Fighters, welcomed Chief Tony Perez to Pasco County. He spoke regarding the change in the County, public safety, sustainable funding, and the need for better resources and continuous support.

Approved to receive and file documents submitted by Mr. Dillon Rich.

Mr. Dillon Rich used a PowerPoint presentation and spoke regarding the Anclote River Park restoration project, the need to preserve the Anclote River Park, concerns of the disturbance and desecration of sacred Native American burial sites, a Florida Anthropologist report dated in 1981, and a report that showed the areas that were tested for artifacts and areas that were not tested for artifacts.

Mr. Charles Carey spoke regarding his residency in Pasco County, the need to repair Lake Iola Road, that he has contacted several people in the County and has not received responses, traffic, and safety concerns.

Chairman Mariano directed Mr. Brandford Adumuah, Assistant County Administrator, Public Infrastructure, to speak with Mr. Carey.

Ms. Doris Carroll thanked the Board for allowing Public Comment that was in opposition of the Anclote River Park Restoration and spoke regarding her history, that there were 1,800 individuals who signed a petition in opposition of the Anclote River Park Restoration, concerns with flooding, taxpayer dollars, and environmental impacts, that the park should be left as it was, and the negative aspects that the restoration would bring to Anclote River Park.
