Call To Order

Chairman Starkey called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

**Invocation
Pledge of Allegiance**

Ms. Alvarez-Sowles gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Roll Call

Ms. Alvarez-Sowles called the roll. All Commissioners were present.

Public Comment

Citizens are given an opportunity to comment on items listed on the Agenda by participating via WebEx during the meeting or attending in person. A WebEx pre-registration process can be found on the Public Comment Options page and must be completed to participate. Citizens may also comment on items listed on the Agenda in person inside the Board Room. The Board will take Public Comment on items on this agenda. It is requested that when you address the Board, that comments are not directed personally against a commissioner or team member, but rather directed at the issues. This provides mutual respect between the board members and the public.

Chairman Starkey reviewed the procedures to be followed and called for public comment.

Approved to receive and file documents submitted by Ms. Nancy Hazelwood.

Ms. Hazelwood spoke regarding the Northeast Protected Area Plan, well and septic, keeping the land rural, the Comprehensive Plan, the packet on Wellfield, the document she distributed, the R49 Test Wellfield study, the Tampa Bay Water website, concerns with how far the well would be from growth in the County and associated costs, whether there would be a Wastewater Treatment Plant, renting sites, and the concern regarding development in the Northeast Rural Protected Area.

Ms. Asia Moore, Vice-President of Florida Uniting Manatee Awareness, spoke regarding the nonprofit organization, the Florida Nature Coast which covered 9 Counties and protection that was needed, dredging of the canals, the Sports Coast being Pasco County, water pollution and the red tide issues, Scallop Season closures, viewing the Nature Coast, Shady Hills Road and the dangers of driving, and living in a rural community.

Ms. Lisa Moretti spoke regarding the Tall Timbers continuance and objecting to the continuance, the bad sharing of information, Agenda availability concerns, that the maps for Tall Timbers were not provided to Planning Commission until 10 a.m. before the meeting, the need for residents to obtain critical information, the Land Use Code and continuance guidelines, the rules, and doing things the way they should be done.

Ms. Ann Marie Winter thanked Pasco County for the partnership with the Area Agency On Aging, thanked Commissioner Weightman for serving on the Board and his guidance, looking forward to having Commissioner Yeager serve as the Pasco County Commissioner seat, thanked Commissioner Oakley's generous donation to the Agency which would be going back out to the community, they would continue to provide meals

to seniors at home, the congregate dining sites, other services that were provided, and the Case Management Program.

Discussion was held regarding congregate dining locations.

Commissioner Oakley noted his appreciation for all she was doing for the aging residents in Pasco and Pinellas Counties, and stated that it was greatly needed and they had done a great job.

Ms. Daphne Sais noted the challenges she faced during construction within the Crela Estates, the ingress and egress that was raised without a permit, that Code Enforcement stated it was a public road, property flooding, backyard retention ponds, trees that had been removed, compromised privacy and security, late night construction, paying property taxes that included part of the ingress and egress, a compensation request, and oversight concerns.

Discussion was held in regard to discussing the matter with an attorney and a site visit; council representation; the County reaching out to Ms. Sais; and that it was a private matter between two property owners.

Ms. Ava Russo noted that she was not speaking for public comment.

Ms. Julia Bartunek spoke regarding the Northeast Rural Pasco Area, the agricultural significance and environmental importance, the Wellfield studies, development concerns, those affected by the recent hurricanes, and building resiliency and sustainability.

Ms. Crista Howell Larkin spoke regarding displacement from the recent hurricanes, having to pay out of pocket, infrastructure improvements, questions not answered by the City, Silver Oaks money allocation issues, home building standards, flooding issues, personal property that was lost and stolen, impacts to peoples lives, and the continued developments within the county.

Discussion was held regarding the losses; a future meeting to discuss the issues; FEMA and insurance issues; and the impact from the hurricanes on the County.

Miscellaneous Business – District One – Commissioner Oakley

- Commissioner Oakley spoke regarding the wildfires on the west coast of the United States and expressed his appreciation for the first responders with the fires and with the flooding that occurred in Pasco County.

Miscellaneous Business – District Two – Commissioner Weightman

- Commissioner Weightman expressed his excitement for the new year, working under the Board's leadership, and the new Committee assignments.

Miscellaneous Business – District Three – Commissioner Starkey

- Chairman Starkey spoke regarding the California fires and a relative that lives in Pacific Palisades and that she was grateful for how Pasco dealt with disasters. She asked about the Red Cross's response.

Discussion was held regarding the response of Red Cross.

- Later in the meeting, she displayed photographs and spoke regarding the Women's Conference of Florida and hoped to send people to the event next year.
- She displayed photographs and noted the volunteer work with Metropolitan Ministries in their tent and gift deliveries by her Staff.

- She spoke regarding following Commissioner Yeager's influence when they were doing food in the Holiday area near Mile Stretch, Mr. Gary Joiner's Bar-be-que not getting a good amount of people, that she loaded up her car and went door-to-door, a gentleman she encountered with no food or car, and wanting the County to visit him. She noted Commissioner Yeager had set a great example for them to follow.
- She spoke regarding the County initiated Community Food Distribution at the St. Vincient de Paul Church.
- She requested a motion to reappoint Ms. Bobbi DeFilippis to the Tourist Development Council.

- She spoke regarding the Committee seats that had been distributed, that the Withlacoochee State Trail did not have a council, and requested important updates from the Committees that the Board members served on.

Commissioner Weightman spoke regarding the Springs Council, how the three Committees were made up, the fundings, and learning facts such as where the bull shark mating grounds were located.

Miscellaneous Business – District Four – Commissioner Yeager

- Commissioner Yeager displayed photographs and spoke regarding the prayer breakfast and having a guest speaker in attendance.
- She displayed photographs and spoke regarding surprising two different senior centers along with Ms. Cathy Pearson, Assistant County Administrator for Public Services, and her grandkids, singing Christmas Carols, and handing out candy canes.
- She displayed photographs and spoke regarding the Christmas event at Moon Lake, feeding 250 families, parents that went shopping, Metro Ministries, Graces Food Pantry, and the River Ridge Basketball Team that was there helping.
- She displayed photographs and spoke regarding a Tunnel to Towers event.

Miscellaneous Business – District Five – Commissioner Mariano

- Commissioner Mariano spoke regarding the comment that was discussed in Public Comment earlier in the meeting pertaining to the Nature Coast and the rebranding of Pasco County to the Sports Coast. He noted the Board had done a

phenomenal job with the restorations and water quality efforts up and down the coast, working closely with Fish and Wildlife, the Scalloping Season, the Aquatic Preserve, the Leisure Beach channel and the low tide, the markers, replanting in Homosassa, sea life, and water quality improvements and channel restorations.

- He noted his appreciation for Staff for working through the storms and for getting people back in their homes.
- He noted that Mr. Kevin Guthrie, Executive Director for the Florida Division of Emergency Management, would be a phenomenal lead for FEMA.

Miscellaneous Business – County Administrator

- Mr. Carballa expressed his appreciation to the Board for approving Addendum item 138 and that Pasco County would be one of three Agencies in the State with the capability to perform quick road clearing and advance search and rescue.
- He noted his appreciation for Mr. Kevin Guthrie's, Executive Director for the Division of Emergency Management, trust in Pasco County to deliver services to the citizens of the State of Florida.
- He spoke regarding the Strategic Plan that had been distributed to the Board and that more information would be presented later on.
- He noted that Pasco County had been a direct recipient of a direct allocation amount of \$585,704,000.00 from HUD and that the funding would have to tie back to the natural disasters, and generally have to benefit low to moderate income individuals. He expressed his appreciation to Ms. Marcy Esbjerg, Community Development Director, and her team for their efforts, a letter that had previously signed by the Chairman, appreciation to Mr. Ralph Lair, Intergovernmental Affairs Officer, and his team for their efforts, they were developing an internal administrative structure, on how to manage it, and the next steps.

Discussion was held regarding meeting with the Commissioners individually as quickly as possible; that NACo handles the money and works with CDBG, HUD, and FEMA; appreciation for the work NACo had done during COVID; that they had not heard anything negative about how the monies had been spent with the Counties; using NACo to know all the rules and if they had any issues; and Lee County.

- Mr. Carballa spoke regarding a thank you letter drafted for the Federal Delegation for any work that had been done behind the scenes to bring that money to Pasco and that it had been addressed from the Chair.

Approved to have the letter signed by the Chair.

- He spoke regarding the upcoming Tri-County Regional Roundtable meeting at the Ruth Eckerd Hall, looking forward to meeting with the rest of the Boards, the presentation from Tampa Bay Water, the brief discussion on the MPO/TPO merger, the opioid funding, the Legislative discussion and what they had done individually as a group for the region, and Pasco County would be hosting the next meeting.
