Updates from Chairman-Appointed Boards and Committees

The updates were provided under Miscellaneous Business.

Miscellaneous Business - District One - Commissioner Oakley

- Commissioner Oakley gave an update on Tampa Bay Water and spoke regarding water that was permitted, the production of grass, pumping approval, public comment, the City of Zephyrhills water, desal water, saltwater wells, and a reservoir.

Discussion was held regarding ag wells; the Howard Curren water; projects that would add water to the system; seagrass in the Bay; advanced wastewater treatment; reclaimed water; the documents distributed by Commissioner Mariano; FGUA properties; a discussion with U.S. Water; well credits; money; and water rights.

- He displayed pictures and spoke regarding his attendance at the 2025 Emergency Services Recognition Ceremony and that he spoke at the Ceremony.
- He displayed pictures and spoke regarding his attendance at the Moffitt site tour and development update, proton therapy, radiation treatments, cell production, new hospitals, that Advent was putting in 124 new beds, and the clinic.
- He spoke regarding that he met with HCA and Mr. Mike Irvan, CEO, that they paid ad-valorem tax to Pasco County, that he was willing to team up to help with projects, and a tour of the hospital.

Discussion was held regarding the hospital.

- Later in the meeting, Commissioner Oakley spoke regarding that he missed the Tri-County meeting and a WREC retirement party.
- He spoke regarding that Metropolitan Ministries had reached out for 30 arm passes.

Discussion was held regarding the ride passes; the prices; that there was a boycott at the fair; and when the fair was.

Miscellaneous Business - District Two - Commissioner Weightman

- Commissioner Weightman gave an update on the Spring Coast Steering Committee and spoke regarding the funding, pots of money, CFI, the South Hillsborough County Transmission Line Project, the Polk Regional Cooperative,

what it was capped at, the long term funding plan, the Basin Management Action Plan (BMAP), projects that were submitted, and the score and rank of projects.

Mr. Adolfo Gonzalez, Director of Utilities Engineering and Contract Management, and Mr. Doug Anderson, Facilities Management, spoke during the discussion.

Discussion was held regarding what they were asking for the project; the total project cost; the applicant share; the Steering Committee dates; the cost for nitrogen removal; grants they had applied for; the design cost; the cooperative funding; projects ranked; Aripeka; septic to sewer; Sea Pines; and the BMAP.

- He spoke regarding appreciation to Senator Fasano for inviting them to the groundbreaking of a new location.
- He spoke regarding the tax discussion, broaching the 40 percent of new revenue that went to the Sheriff's Department, a Law Enforcement MSTU, the Constitutional Officers, and budgets.

Discussion was held regarding the MSTU; the Sheriff's budget; the first budget cycle; the Fire MSTU; and the opportunities that it would give the Constitutionals.

- He spoke regarding the prayer and a prayer a clerk did at a YMCA breakfast a few years ago.

Discussion was held regarding the prayer; what the other counties did; a non-denominational prayer; what the State Legislature did; the reason the prayer was developed; and a time of silence.

- Chairman Starkey gave an update on the Tourism Development Council and spoke regarding that the numbers were up, events in Pasco County, and writers at the Kumquat Festival.

Discussion was held regarding the Senior Games and the golf game.

- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding the South Harbors Leadership Council, the Trinity Odessa Leadership Council, and who presented.
- She spoke regarding that she was awarded one of the Women of Distinction awards, Commissioners who were in attendance, that there was a luncheon on March 12th, and appreciation to the Girls Scouts of West Central Florida.

- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding her attendance at the Tri-County Workshop, the opioid discussion, and the Commissioners from Hillsborough.

Discussion was held regarding the Tri-County Workshop; the pictures from the meeting; that the next meeting was May 2nd; the old Target building; City Councils and Mayors; the BRT; the Hillsborough MPO and their TPO; TMA and CSX; HUD money; and when the action plans were due.

- She displayed pictures and spoke regarding the Moffitt site tour.
- She spoke regarding that AmSkills started a class for trafficked women, the centerpieces, when Moffitt visited, and the Created Class.

Discussion was held regarding other counties that required a human trafficking course for vendors and employees who were mandated to take a course for awareness.

- She spoke regarding that she had asked Staff to test the Odessa Lakes for contamination.
- She spoke regarding a NACo housing discussion that Mr. Carballa and she participated in and a grant.
- She spoke regarding that she needed answers on SWFWMD, Starkey Ranch, and The Preserve.
- She spoke regarding something floating in the water behind her house in Gulf Harbors.

Discussion was held regarding who was responsible; that it was a hazard in navigation; the location; and that pylons and channel markers were missing.

- Later in the meeting, she spoke regarding that she was not going to be at the next Board meeting.
- She spoke regarding the County Commission's first Food Distribution at Mile Stretch.

Discussion was held regarding appreciation to those involved and who had helped; that there was a contractor that handled water debris; the Harbors South Leadership meeting; contacting the Solid Waste Department; and debris clean up.

- She spoke regarding citizens in Holiday that stated their water smelled.

Discussion was held regarding appreciation to Staff; the pickup that went on; FEMA; and local businesses.

- She spoke regarding that the Legislative Conference was at the end of February and people in the White House.

Discussion was held regarding whether they could extend their stay; appointments with elected officials; and Attorney General Bondi.

Miscellaneous Business - District Four - Commissioner Yeager

- Commissioner Yeager gave an update on the Human Trafficking Board and spoke regarding the Strategic Plan, budgeting, and TV ads.
